

# Common Imports

Here's a list of common imports, used in Angular components.

NOTE: Usage requires an import statement and adding the module to the Imports block of your component.

## Common Module

Provides core directives like `*ngIf`, `*ngFor`, `ngClass`, `ngStyle`, etc.

Imported as:

```
import { CommonModule } from '@angular/common';
```

## Forms Module

If your component uses template-driven forms (`ngModel`), import `FormsModule`.

Imported with this:

```
import { FormsModule } from '@angular/forms';
```

## Reactive Forms Module

If using reactive forms (`FormGroup`, `FormControl`), import `ReactiveFormsModule`

Imported with this:

```
import { ReactiveFormsModule } from '@angular/forms';
```

## Angular Material

There are several imports for this, depending on what elements you use.

```
import { MatCardModule } from '@angular/material/card';  
import { MatDividerModule } from '@angular/material/divider';  
import { MatListModule } from '@angular/material/list';  
import { MatIconModule } from '@angular/material/icon';
```

CDK Drag and Drop

Imported with this:

```
import {DragDropModule} from '@angular/cdk/drag-drop';
```
